

## **IEA Cedar Lodge Equestrian Team** **Cost and Requirements**

### **Just the facts:**

- Open to riders in grades 9 -12 and riders in grades 6 – 8.
- To qualify for points, riders must attend a minimum of 2 shows. Can show in no more than 5.
- Full show attire required. Selection of coats, shirts, riding pants and boots of various sizes in stock.
- Cedar Lodge coaches decide class(s) for each rider to participate in for season.

### **Cedar Lodge Riding Requirements:**

*Riders that have attended camp in just past summer or are taking regular lessons at Cedar Lodge:*

No evaluation ride.

*Riders from other barns:* Evaluation ride before their first show at a cost of \$25.00.

*All riders that are in a regular lesson program at Cedar Lodge or other barn:* Minimum of three lessons at Cedar Lodge during the show season, either by weekly/monthly lessons by appointment(team price of \$25.00/lesson), or attending a riding weekend at Cedar Lodge. IEA weekends break down at a cost of 20/night, 10/meal, 25/lesson. 2 lessons Saturday and 2 lessons Sunday are available (morning and afternoon).

*For riders not in a regular riding lesson program:* Two riding lesson each month during show season.

*Note:* If riders or the team qualifies for regional, zone or national championship (occurs in March/April) additional lessons will be required.

**Team Practice Weekends are listed on the Cedar Lodge calendar of events on the Cedar Lodge web site, or posted on the Cedar Lodge Equestrian Team facebook page. Monthly notifications are also emailed to all team members.**

\*Most other weekends will have an 11AM open team practice lesson on Saturdays, and be open to private lessons by request.

### **Competitions:**

- posted on Cedar Lodge web site and facebook page and emailed monthly. Teams add dates constantly, so check back often. Also available on IEA show calendar.

### **Costs:**

- Annual Fee of \$60.00 membership paid to IEA.
- Annual team fee of \$35.00.
- Individual class cost of \$40.00 per class. Each rider will show in one or two classes (dependent on rider level at beginning show season).
- Coaching fee \$25.00/rider/show
- Housing either at camp (\$20.00/night) or Motel
- Food Expenses
- Travel Expenses to be determine by distance and number of riders
