

## **Cedar Lodge Pre-Camp COVID Testing**

We are asking all campers to be COVID tested with a nasal swab prior to attending camp. This must be completed no earlier than 10 days before camp starts. Please contact the testing site to see how long results will take to return as times vary greatly. Below are recommended testing sites in the Detroit, Chicago and Kalamazoo area that do not require symptoms.
